As we return to school, it is important to remind all families that Covid -19 is still a very real concern in society. In order to ensure the safe return of all children it is essential that everyone continues to follow the Government guidelines. I also would like to remind everyone that any class may still have to undertake a period of remote learning should a positive case of Covid-19 occur. All staff are currently participating in an asymptomatic testing programme and all families should have procedures in place to ensure children have care should this happen.
