There has been much in the news recently about a show called **Squid Game**, which is primarily on Netflix but is also accessible through online platforms such as ticktock. The content of this show is disturbing and not appropriate for children in any way.

It has been concerning to hear that some children in school have been using terminology linked to this programme and playing using actions which may reflect it. Whilst it is not always clear where children pick up terminology and vocabulary from, as a school we would like to remind all parents that this material is unsuitable for children. I would also like to stress that **T.V programmes** and **games** with a certificate of 15 are not in any way appropriate for primary aged children. Indeed, children should be safeguarded from material that is not age appropriate. As a school we will be monitoring this carefully and ask as parents you support all of our children by being very aware of the material they are viewing on TV, online or in gaming capacity. We will not be allowing any games or language in school that replicates or is connected to this material. Thank you.
