## **Emergency Care**

In line with Government guidance, we are continuing to arrange *emergency* care for children of key workers next week. We are continuing to organise this provision in our school with our staff between the hours of **8:45am and 3:30pm**. The care will follow the same structure as before the Easter Break.

Whilst school will continue to offer the emergency care, I ask all of our families to continue to support school by working within the government guidance '*when possible children should remain at home as this is the safest place for them.*'

- 1. Please give the name(s) of your child (ren).
- 2. Please state the days over the next week that you will require care. We will need to know which days next week exactly you require emergency care as this will impact upon the arrangements that we need to put in place and allow us to ensure the safety of staff and children. Each Thursday we will ask you to confirm this for the week ahead.

It will be important to have this information by *Friday 11:00 am* at the latest. We will then reply to your e:mail confirming the arrangements.

If you have any concerns about these arrangements or do not hear about care we have organised for your child on Friday, please email or call school and I will discuss concerns with you.
