Changes to Covid-19 Isolation Guidance

From 24th February, the Government removed the legal requirement to self-isolate following a positive test. Adults and children who test positive will **continue to be advised to stay at home and avoid contact with other people**. After 5 days, they may choose to take a Lateral Flow Device (LFD) followed by another the next day - if both are negative, and they do not have a temperature, they can safely return to their normal routine.
