## School lunches

## <u>P.E</u>

Each week children will have two P.E lessons. One P.E lesson will be from a West Lancashire Sports Coach and the other will be with their class teacher.

Children should arrive at school in their P.E kits when it is there P.E day. They should wear trainers, their white P.E top and blue shorts with a school jumper over the top. In addition, if children wish to wear tracksuit bottoms over their shorts they are able to. Each class has two P.E days which are outlined below.
